Directions Diabeter Center Amsterdam

Diabeter Centrum Amsterdam is easily accessible by car, public transport or bicycle.

Auto

Coming from both the north and south on the Ring A10, take exit 7. At the end of the exit, follow the S107/Henk Sneevlietweg traffic lights. At the next traffic lights, turn right onto Johan Huizingalaan and immediately after that, at the first intersection, turn left onto Louwesweg. At the first intersection after the bus and tram stop, turn right and continue along Louwesweg. The entrance to Diabeter Centrum Amsterdam can be found after 200 meters on the right.

If you come by car, you can use the parking garage or the disabled parking lot (P1 and P2). Please note that if you park in the disabled parking lot, you must place the disabled card clearly visible in the car. For more information, see below under 'Parking'.

Public transport

The nearest tram and bus stops are Louwesweg and Johan Huizingalaan. Tram 2 and buses 18, 62, 195, 247 and N88 stop here. In addition, Heemstedestraat and Henk Sneevlietweg metro stops are approximately a 10-minute walk away and Amsterdam Lelylaan train station is a few blocks away.

Bicycle

At Diabeter Centrum Amsterdam there are enough possibilities to put your bike away. This can be your own bike, but also an OV-bike. At train station Amsterdam Lelylaan you can rent an OV-bike.

Parking

As a visitor of Diabeter Centrum Amsterdam you can park for a fee in the parking garage or the disabled parking lot (P1 and P2) on the premises. Please note that if you park in the disabled parking lot you place the disabled card clearly visible in the car.

The address of the parking garage and parking lot is Louwesweg 12.

Location of parking garage and parking lot

You will find the parking garage and the parking lot from the entrance on the Louwesweg after 500 meters on the left and from the entrance on the Plesmanlaan after 200 meters on the right. This is also indicated on the signs.

Costs

The parking fee is €2.40 per hour for the first hour. After that €0.60 per quarter. The first 15 minutes are free.

The rates apply as of January 1, 2023 and are subject to change.
